On or about June 15, 2012, Respondent made application 20 to the Bureau of Real Estate of the State of California for a 21 real estate salesperson license. 22 23 (CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS) 24 2. 25 On or about October 8, 1992, in the Superior Court of 26

California, County of San Diego, Case No. ECR5853, Respondent

was convicted of violating California Penal Code section 242 (battery), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

3.

On or about January 25, 2002, in the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, Case No. C217969, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code section 23152(a) (driving under the influence), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

4.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted as alleged in Paragraphs 2 and 3, above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

(FAILURE TO REVEAL CONVICTIONS)

5.

In response to Part D - Question 1 of his license application, to wit: "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF A MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY? CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.4 MUST BE DISCLOSED. HOWEVER, YOU MAY OMIT TRAFFIC CITATIONS WHICH DO NOT CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY,"

Respondent answered "No," and failed to reveal the convictions described in Paragraphs 2 and 3, above.

6.

Respondent's failure to reveal these convictions in his license application constitutes knowingly making a false statement of material fact required to be revealed in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under California Business and Professions Code sections 475(a)(1), 480(c), and 10177(a).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the
charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real
estate salesperson license to Respondent, ERIC JOEL KERSTEN, and
for such other and further relief as may be proper under other
applicable provisions of law.
