ORDER GRANTING REMOVAL OF DISCIPLINE INFORMATION FROM RESPONDENT'S
PUBLIC INFORMATION PAGE ON THE DEPARTMENT OF REAL ESTATE'S WEBSITE

On December 16, 1997, in Case No. H-26961 LA, a Decision was rendered disciplining the real estate broker license of Respondent, effective January 8, 1998. On November 28, 2001, in Case No. H-28969 LA, a Decision was rendered disciplining the real estate broker license of Respondent effective December 26, 2001. On May 9, 2008, in Case No. H-38211 LA, a Desist and Refrain Order was filed against Respondent.

On April 20, 2023, Respondent was granted the reinstatement of Respondent's real estate broker license.

On November 16, 2022, Respondent petitioned for the removal of discipline information from Respondent's Public Information Page on the Department of Real Estate's Website ("the Website").

1 I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support
2 thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent does not present a
3 credible risk to the public and that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the removal of
4 discipline from the Website and that it would not be against the public interest for removal of said
5 discipline.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for removal
7 of discipline information from the Website is granted, pending the issuance of a real estate broker
8 license to Respondent.
