ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On November 12, 2003, in Case No. H-29711 LA, a Decision was rendered revoking the real estate broker license of Respondent effective December 4, 2003.

On November 16, 2016, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of a previously held real estate salesperson license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate salesperson license and that it would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

7 salesperson license.
