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## ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Order filed March 14, 2013, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Respondent.

On August 6, 2004, a Decision was rendered herein revoking the real estate salesperson license of Respondent, but granting the right to a restricted license. The restricted license was issued to Respondent on August 31, 2004, and expires August 30, 2016.

On or about October 31, 2011, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate salesperson license.

On November 28, 2012, an Order Granting Reinstatement of License was signed. Said Order became effective immediately and was filed and served on March 14, 2013.

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Said Order provided that an unrestricted real estate salesperson license will be issued to Respondent if Respondent satisfies the following conditions within the twelve month period from the effective date of the Order:

- 1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate salesperson license.
- 2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education courses must be completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.

Good cause having been shown, the time during which Respondent must complete the conditions described above is hereby extended to March 14, 2014.
