	22	Code (hereinafter "Code"), Respondent made application to the
	23	Department of Real Estate of the State of California (hereinafter
	24	"Department") for a real estate salesperson license with the
	25	knowledge and understanding that any license issued as a result
	26	of said application would be subject to the conditions of Section
	27	10153.4 of the Code.
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In response to Question #25 of her original application for a real estate license, to wit, "Have you ever been convicted of any violation of law? Convictions expunged under Penal Code Section 1203.4 must be disclosed. However, you may omit minor traffic citations which do not constitute a misdemeanor or felony offense." Respondent answered "No", and failed to disclose the conviction set forth in Paragraph 3 below.

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10 On or about March 13, 1992, in the Superior/Municipal 11 Court of California, County of Orange, Respondent was convicted 12 of violating Penal Code Section 484-488 (Petty Theft), a 13 misdemeanor and crime, which by its circumstances, involved moral 14 turpitude and is substantially related to the qualifications, 15 functions and duties of a real estate licensee. Respondent was 16 placed on probation for three (3) years, which included serving 17 three days in jail or payment of a fine.

Respondent's conviction as set forth in Paragraph 3, above, constitutes grounds to deny Respondent's application for a real estate license pursuant to Code Sections 10177(b) and 480(a).

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Respondent's failure to disclose the conviction set forth in Paragraph 3 constitutes grounds to deny her application for a real estate license pursuant to Code Sections 10177(a) and 480(c).
