## ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On May 3, 2012, in Case No. H-37413 LA, a Decision was rendered revoking the real estate corporation license of Respondent effective June 6, 2012, but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate corporation license. A restricted real estate corporation license was issued to Respondent on June 6, 2012, and Respondent has held a restricted license since that time.

On March 5, 2019, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of Respondent's real estate corporation license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate corporation license and that it would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for reinstatement is granted and that a real estate corporation license be issued to Respondent if Respondent satisfies the following requirements:

1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate corporation license within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.
