STATEMENT OF ISSUES

The Complainant, Maria Suarez, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, acting in her official capacity, for Statement of Issues against WLEHYONNEH T. TOLES aka Wlehyonneh Toles ("Respondent") alleges as follows:

1.

On or about August 23, 2013, Respondent made application to the Bureau of Real Estate ("Bureau") of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license.

FIRST CAUSE FOR DENIAL (CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

2.

On or about November 15, 2005, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in Case No. 5WL13536, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Section 484(a) (Petty Theft), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

3.

On or about July 5, 2007, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in Case No. 7PY03321, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Section 487(a) (Grand Theft), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted as alleged above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

SECOND CAUSE FOR DENIAL

(FAILURE TO DISCLOSE)

5.

In response to PART D, Question 1 of the license application, to wit: HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF LAW? ALL STATE AND FEDERAL MISDEMEANOR AND FELONY CONVICTIONS, AND ALL MILITARY AND FOREIGN CONVICTIONS, MUST BE DISCLOSED. CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.4 OR A SIMILAR STATUTE MUST STILL BE DISCLOSED.", Respondent marked the box denoted "No," and failed to disclose the convictions described in paragraphs 2 and 3, above.

6.

Respondent's failure to reveal the conviction set forth herein in paragraphs 2 and 3, above, in his license application constitutes an attempt to procure a real estate license by fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or by making a material misstatement of fact, or by knowingly omitting to state a material fact in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(1), 480(c), and/or 10177(a).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.
