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On or about October 26, 2016, Respondent made application to the Bureau of Real Estate ("Bureau") of the State of California for an individual mortgage loan originator ("MLO") license endorsement.

GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OF MLO LICENSE ENDORSEMENT

4.

Section 10166.05(c) of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Commissioner shall not issue a MLO license endorsement to an applicant unless said applicant has demonstrated such financial responsibility, character, and general fitness as to command the confidence of the community and warrant a determination that the mortgage loan originator will operate honestly, fairly, and efficiently within the purposes of the article.

5.

Section 10166.051(b) of the Code provides that the Commissioner may deny, suspend, revoke, condition, or decline to renew a mortgage loan originator license endorsement, if an applicant or endorsement holder fails at any time to meet the requirements of Section 10166.05 or 10166.09, or withholds information or makes a material misstatement in an application for a license endorsement or license endorsement renewal.

6.

Section 2945.2(b) of Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations ("Regulations") provides that where a real estate licensee subject to a real estate license discipline action filed by the Bureau on January 1, 2010, or later, resulting in a revocation, a suspension, a voluntary surrender of a real estate license, a public reproval, and/or bar order, such discipline alone may be cause for denial of a subsequent mortgage loan originator license endorsement.

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(PRIOR LICENSE DISCIPLINARY ACTION)

On September 26, 2012, the Bureau¹ filed an Accusation in Bureau Case No. H-38444 LA, against International Team Realty² and Respondent, individually and as designated officer of International Team Realty, based on audit examinations of Respondent's mortgage loan broker activity and International Team Realty's broker escrow activity, mortgage loan broker activity and real estate resale activity.

8.

On January 15, 2014, Respondent executed a Stipulation and Agreement ("Stipulation") in Case No. H-38444 LA where Respondent stipulated to the acts and omissions in the Accusation as grounds for disciplinary action in that he, individually and as designated officer of International Team Realty, committed violations of the Real Estate Law and Regulations, including in part Code sections 10145 (trust fund shortage), 10159.2 (failure to supervise), 10159.5 (unauthorized fictitious business name), 10176(a) (misrepresentation), and 10240(c) (failure to provide written disclosure statement), and Regulations section 2832.1 (trust fund shortage). On March 3, 2014, the Real Estate Commissioner ("Commissioner") adopted the Stipulation as his Decision and ordered the suspension of Respondent's real estate broker license for 90 days. Said suspension was stayed for 30 days on the condition that Respondent pay a monetary penalty. The remaining 60 days were stayed under certain terms and conditions. Moreover, Respondent was ordered to take and pass the Professional Responsibility Examination, successfully complete the continuing education requirements, and successfully complete the continuing education requirements, and successfully complete the continuing education requirements, and successfully

In response to Question (K) in the section entitled "Regulatory Action" under "Disclosure Questions" of Respondent's MLO license endorsement application submitted on October 26, 2016, to wit: "Has any State or federal agency or foreign financial regulatory authority or self-regulatory organization (SRO) ever:...(2) found you to have been involved in a violation of a financial services-related business regulation(s) or statutes(s)?" Respondent answered "No," which constitutes the withholding of information or the making of a material misstatement as to the suspension of his real estate broker license on March 26, 2014, as described in Paragraph 9, above.

In response to Question (K) in the section entitled "Regulatory Action" under "Disclosure Questions" of Respondent's MLO license endorsement application submitted on October 26, 2016, to wit: "Has any State or federal agency or foreign financial regulatory authority or self-regulatory organization (SRO) ever:...(4) entered an order against you in connection with a financial services-related activity?" Respondent answered "No," which constitutes the withholding of information or the making of a material misstatement as to the suspension of his real estate broker license on March 26, 2014, as described in Paragraph 9, above.

In response to Question (K) in the section entitled "Regulatory Action" under "Disclosure Questions" of Respondent's MLO license endorsement application submitted on October 26, 2016, to wit: "Has any State or federal agency or foreign financial regulatory authority or self-regulatory organization (SRO) ever:...(6) denied or suspended your registration or license or application for licensure, disciplined you, or otherwise by order, prevented you from associating with a financial services-related business or restricted your activities?" Respondent answered "No," which constitutes the withholding of information or

L6	These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division		
17	4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through		
18	11528 of the California Government Code.		
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1	WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for	
2	hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to	
3	authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a MLO license endorsement to Respondent	
4	RICK ARCINIEGA and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other	
5	applicable provisions of law.
